IMPORTANT HIGHLIGHT INFORMATION

- If your child's school is closed for winter break the week you receive the entry, mail a <u>copy</u> of the grade verification/medical release by the correct post mark date, then follow up with the <u>original</u> signed by the school so I have it by the draw date of March 10th.
- Students Must Include Most Recent grading period report issued by the school with their forms!
- Alternates in events, wait to be notified by their rodeo secretary. This could even be after the closing date, when all final entries are in.
- <u>STALLING</u>: NO PORTABLE PENS PERMITTED....YOU NEED TO RESERVE A STALL. \$45 FOR THE WEEKEND.
- <u>CHECK IN TIMES</u>: Please pay close attention to Closing Times for Check In. Any contestant who misses check in time will unfortunately be disqualified! Be sure to wear your District Vest!
- <u>CAMPING</u>: Fee is \$50 for the duration starting Thursday, regardless of number of nights through the weekend. Request must be indicated on Entry, everyone pays the same, with or without electricity. There are very limited hookups, no reserving, and its first come first serve! <u>CHSRA rents the grounds starting Thursday, if you arrive before that, expect to pay the Fairgrounds directly for overnight camping, \$25.</u>

<u>Permit Tag to display in window of vehicle will be given to contestant when they check in.</u>

• All contestants must be in Western Attire while in and around the arena and grandstands during the rodeo performances, whether they are up in that performance or not.

In an effort to keep Challenge of Champions expenses to a minimum, the CHSRA Board of Directors has made a decision to forgo the additional cost for the felt back numbers.




